



Dr. Randy O. Frost received his Ph.D. from the University of Kansas in 1977 and is the Harold and Elsa Siipola Israel Professor of Psychology at Smith College in Massachusetts, USA. He is an internationally recognized expert on obsessive-compulsive disorder and hoarding disorder and has published more than 170 scientific articles, books and book chapters on these topics.

Dr. Frost has co-authored several book on hoarding including *Buried in Treasures: Help for Compulsive Acquiring, Saving and Hoarding* (with Drs. David Tolin and Gail Steketee)
